## PART 4: Framework For Authorization Success

There is no script for talking to families. Having a framework allows for consistency and maximum recall when working with families to: a) build trust and form bonds; b) introduce yourself and express condolences in the most sensitive manner possible despite challenges; c) assess a family's understanding; d) give detailed clinical information on Braindead and DCD cases; e) utilize crucial learned information; f) sensitively transition into donation in the most effective manner possible.

- Acquiring helpful information from hospital staff to help aid you in your family conversation
- Introduction techniques: Not all introductions are created equal, how to work through challenges
- Is the family ready for the donation conversation? Completing a good family assessment
- Making no assumptions on family understanding of clinical information: BD and DCD explanations (keeping it simple)
- Forming bonds and building trust utilizing huddle information
- Successful transitions using gold standard language
